At our state-of-the-art facility outside of Austin, our CBD-rich cannabis strains are grown from seed through harvest utilizing a **pesticide-free environment**. After harvest, we use a hydrocarbon-free, high purity CO₂ extraction process to produce our cannabis oil, achieving cannabinoid purities as high as 99 percent.

All of our products undergo **rigorous testing in our laboratory**—outfitted with over \$1 million in advanced equipment—to ensure purity, consistency and that the oil is free of any heavy metals, microbials and chemical contaminants. In our commitment to transparency, all production-batch test results are publicly available. Each bottle of medicine is labeled clearly to state cannabinoid composition and batch traceability.

As **Texas' first-ever licensed medical cannabis dispensary**, we have built a patient-friendly environment and also offer statewide delivery.

FAQ

Q: My doctor has approved my prescription—what are the next steps?

1. Call our dispensary at 512-467-4118 to confirm your prescription is active before placing order. You will need patient's last name, date of birth and last five digits of Social Security Number. **(Note: Compassionate Cultivation doesn't receive notifications of active prescriptions. We must be informed by the patient or physician's office directly.)**
2. After prescription is verified, patient / caregiver can consult with dispensary staff to choose product size and flavor and confirm dosage and duration.
3. Pick up filled prescription at dispensary or schedule delivery. There is a delivery charge for orders totalling less than \$250. We also offer a 10% discount* for in-dispensary pickup. *Cannot be combined with other discounts.

Q: What do I need to receive my medication, and who is eligible to receive medication on behalf of patients?

A valid ID must be presented and match information in CURT.

MINORS (UNDER 18): Any caregiver who will be picking up or receiving medication on behalf of a patient must inform prescribing physician to enter caregiver's personal information in the Compassionate Use Registry of Texas (CURT) as a guardian—this includes parents, nurse caregivers, adult siblings or relatives.

Q: Who should I ask about dosing and interactions with a patient's current medications?

All dosing and medical questions should be referred to the prescribing physician.

Q: How should I store my oil?

Store oil in a cool, dry place. Avoid direct sunlight and extreme heat. Refrigeration is not recommended.

Q: What are the side effects when using this CBD oil?

There are minimal side effects reported with usage. Some patients on higher dosages have experienced mild gastrointestinal issues and mild sleepiness. Please ask your prescribing physician about potential interactions with other medications.

Q: Are there any artificial dyes, added sugars or allergens in your product?

There are no dyes in our products. In our unflavored product, there are no additives; it is strictly cannabis oil extract and USP-grade MCT oil. The Mint product is flavored with all-natural peppermint oil. The Cherry product uses all-natural almond oil containing a minute amount of artificial cherry flavoring. For patients with nut sensitivities or an aversion to MCT oil, we offer an unflavored safflower oil-based option.

Q: Do I need to take my medicine with food or water? Can I take this medication at the same time as my other anti-seizure medications?

There is no indication that taking with or without food or water with other medications will affect the efficacy of this medicine; however, as with other medications, taking on a full stomach could delay but not dilute the effects.

Q: Does health insurance or Medicaid cover my prescription?

Currently our medicine is not covered by insurance or Medicaid; however, some FSA and HSA cards are accepted. To use FSA /

HSA accounts, please make sure you have the associated PIN to complete the transaction.

Q: Are there discounts offered?

Compassionate Cultivation offers a 10% discount for in-dispensary pick-ups and a 10% discount to military families with valid proof of service. Ask about our loyalty program.

Q: How do I get a refill on my medication?

Please contact your prescribing physician's office for a refill. We recommend starting this process approximately one week prior to running out of medication, as sometimes it takes a few days for doctors to get necessary approvals.

Q: What forms of payment do you accept?

We accept cash, checks, money orders and debit cards. We also have an ACH account for direct payment via a patient's bank account with zero fees.

Q: Can I travel with my medication?

IN STATE: When traveling within Texas, always keep your prescription information handy, along with the Compassionate Use Registry of Texas (CURT) verification phone number (833-244-6702) located on the patient insert and bottle label. Our medicine is treated as a Schedule I substance and prescription verification may be necessary.

OUTSIDE OF TEXAS AND U.S.: It's important to remember that cannabis-based medicine is a federally illegal substance.* While it's unlikely you will be questioned, there is no official guidance from the Texas Department of Public Safety on this subject and it is unknown how it would be handled out-of-state.

**This applies to air travel, border patrol and shipping via postal service, as these are federally regulated entities.*
